As part of our history unit this term, year 5 will be going on an excursion to Lanyon House to explore the history of the house and experience what life may have been like for a convict. The visit will complement the lessons taught in class.

What to bring: Students are to wear full school uniform, joggers and must have a broad brimmed or bucket hat to wear outside. We will be eating recess and lunch at Lanyon House, so all students will require a backpack to carry their food, water bottle, pencil case and hat.

The school has made every effort to keep the cost for this activity to a reasonable level. The school has a student support fund to provide financial assistance for students where parents are unable to pay the required excursion costs. Please speak to Tanya Price, Business Manager, if you require assistance.

The permission note must be returned to the school no later than Wednesday 6 September. Please be aware that notes will not be accepted after the due date. Children without permission notes will not be able to attend the excursion.

- Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.*
- Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and to property, of impulsive, willful or disobedient behaviour.*
