

## Year 6 Graduation Celebrations

Dear Parents and Carers

This note contains information regarding the following Year 6 Graduation celebrations. Permission notes, order forms and payment forms are at the end of the graduation information. Please note that the cost of the celebrations has been substantially subsidised due to some generous donations.

### Graduation Ceremony

As part of the Year 6 farewell activities, we will be holding the 2021 Year 6 Graduation Ceremony on Tuesday 14 December. On advice from the ACT Education Directorate and ACT Health, the 2021 Graduation Ceremony will be significantly different to previous years' ceremonies. Please read the information below carefully, as it is important that we are all following our COVID-Safe Event Plan. It should also be noted that the situation can change very quickly. We need to be mindful of the fact that the planned Graduation Ceremony may be subject to change or cancellation due to a need to amend the public health advice and/or directions at short notice.

**Details of Macgregor Primary's 2021 Year 6 Graduation Ceremony are as follows:**

<b>Location</b>	Macgregor Primary School Hall
<b>Participants</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Year 6 students – other students at the school will have the opportunity to watch the Graduation Ceremony live streamed to their classrooms</li> <li>Macgregor Primary School staff</li> <li>A <b>maximum of two (2)</b> supporting adults per graduating Year 6 student – please see below for important RSVP information.</li> </ul>
<b>Cost and Ticketing</b>	There will be no cost for the Graduation Ceremony, but the supporting adult(s) accompanying the graduating Year 6 students will be issued with a numbered seating ticket and advised of the door to use to enter the Hall (to assist with flow of attendees and social distancing).
<b>Date</b>	Tuesday 14 December 2021
<b>RSVP due</b>	Monday 6 December 2021 ( <b>2 adults only</b> )
<b>Arrival Time and arrangements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The doors to the Hall will be open from 09:15am for a 10:00am start</li> <li>Adults are advised to arrive early to enter the Hall through a designated door (to assist with flow of attendees and social distancing). This will be indicated on your ticket</li> <li>Hand sanitiser will be available for adults to use prior to moving into the hall</li> <li>All adults in attendance are required to wear masks when inside the school</li> <li>Staff will be assisting at the doors and only adults with a numbered seating ticket through RSVP can attend the ceremony</li> <li>There is no standing room available in the hall or doorways</li> <li>If you would like wheelchair access, please let us know by indicating on the RSVP</li> <li>Unfortunately, no prams can be accommodated in the hall due to allowing space for social distancing.</li> </ul>
<b>Departure Time and arrangements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Graduation Ceremony is anticipated to finish at 11:30am</li> <li>Supporting adults will be asked to leave the school as quickly as possible and not mingle within the school grounds</li> <li>Once again, it is important that families continue to socially distance and we will have signage posted in the green space as a reminder.</li> </ul>
<b>Other important information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Physical distancing of 1.5 metres must always be maintained between adults. This does not apply to adults living in the same household</li> <li>All adults in attendance are required to wear masks when inside the school</li> <li>Hygiene stations will be available, and you are encouraged to use them</li> </ul>

- Please stay home if you are unwell and get tested if COVID-19 symptoms are being experienced (regardless of how mild).
- Please remain seated on your allocated seat during the Graduation Ceremony except when arriving and leaving, or when using bathroom facilities
- Please check in via the Check in CBR app.

A COVID-Safe Event Plan has been prepared for the Graduation Ceremony and is available for viewing at the school.
