



Dear Parents and Carers

At Macgregor Preschool, we view all children as unique, creative, capable, and competent learners. We recognise that children learn through play, can make decisions to inform their own learning and have differing needs, interests, backgrounds, and abilities. This term we will be supporting the children in developing a sense of 'belonging' at preschool. We will achieve this by offering experiences that support each child in forming positive relationships with their peers and educators. Together we will explore the concepts of friendship, inclusivity, and individuality through quality children's literature. We will assist the children in developing their self-confidence and communication skills through provocations, investigations, intentional teaching, differentiated activities and whole group discussions.

Intentional Teaching

Educators draw on a rich repertoire of teaching practices to promote learning at preschool including:

- providing time, space and learning activities that facilitate thoughtful and challenging conversations with children.
 - engaging with children by listening, showing interest and asking open ended questions to encourage thinking and communication.
 - using a range of experiences that involve explanations, speculation and problem solving.
 - collaborating with children to develop further knowledge and skills, and extend perspectives.
 - using teaching strategies that compliment the goals for each child's learning.
- Providing instructional / intentional support to children during play, routines and transitions.

Preschool Learning Program

Our learning programs will be posted to Seesaw. Photos/videos of learning will also be regularly shared to your child's journal. Educators appreciate and value your feedback and encourage families to share their thoughts and ideas with us.

Wellbeing @ Macgregor (W@M) / Preschool Equipment

Macgregor Primary School has a *Wellbeing at Macgregor* framework, also known as **W@M**. As part of this wellbeing framework, we encourage all children to care for their own, and the belongings of others. Key concepts including kindness and sharing (taking turns) will be embedded in our term 1 programs. The classes will develop routines and agreements at preschool regarding caring for the indoor and outdoor preschool environment. Mindfulness sessions will occur daily. If you would like further information about our wellbeing program, please ask, we are always happy to answer your questions.

Wet Weather Gear and Spare Clothes

At Macgregor Preschool we run an 'all weather' program, meaning we continue to explore our outdoor environment even when it's cold and damp, so please remember to pack clothing appropriate to the weather forecast. We also request that each child has a change of weather appropriate spare clothes in their school bag every day.

Illness

We kindly ask that you keep your child at home if they show any signs of illness. We will make contact with you through the day if your child becomes unwell and needs to go home

Healthy Lunchboxes and Allergies



Thank you for packing a variety of healthy foods in your child's lunchbox each day. Please ensure you provide a water bottle, educators can refill these when needed. Please refrain from sending a juice box or milk to preschool. To keep all students safe, please do not **pack any nut products including Nutella. We ask that you also try to avoid sending sesame seeds, blackberries, lentils, pistachios, peaches, fish and seafood.**
