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Mathematics

Children will be given many hands-on opportunities to understand and explore:

- Number names, numerals and quantities to at least 120
- Partitioning numbers into tens and ones
- Comparing and discussing data.

Visual Art

Students will explore what it means to be inspired and different ways we can respond through the arts. They will explore the elements of visual art and how they can help us to express our ideas effectively.

Our W@M lessons this term will focus on appropriate ways to express our emotions.

English

The students will continue to develop their skills in reading, writing, viewing and oral language. Children will have daily opportunities to develop:

- Their understanding of phonics
- Effective decoding strategies
- Writing short texts for a range of purposes
- Active listening and appropriate interaction skills.

Physical Education

Students will continue developing:

- Fundamental movement skills
- Participation in cooperative games
