Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to our second term of Kindergarten. We hope everyone had a relaxing break. This overview is a brief outline of what your child will be learning this term. Please make sure that your child's belongings are labelled. The weather is cooling down so please ensure your child has a jumper in their bag each day.

Our specialist classes (Art, PE, Sustainability) are scheduled for Wednesday 12pm to 3pm.

Mathematics

This term, students will be given many hands-on opportunities to understand and explore:

- Number - quantifying numbers 1-10, partitioning collections up to 10, sharing collections equally, and adding/subtracting to 10 and beyond
- Measurement - comparing length, exploring capacity and sequencing and connecting familiar events to the time of day
- Algebra - copying and continuing repeating patterns.



English

This term we will continue to deliver the our explicit literacy program, focusing on:

- Letter-sound knowledge (o, c, d, h, e, n, g, l, k, u, and b)
- Handwriting
- Introducing high frequency words and tricky words (words that are difficult to sound out).

Students will work in small groups with their teacher to:

- Build words using familiar letters and sounds
- Read decodable texts
- Develop comprehension strategies.

In writing, teachers will continue to use the 'I do, we do, you do' model. Children will be encouraged to independently write after modelling and guided practise.

Cross Curricular

We will be exploring materials of different objects and how they move. Our guiding questions include:

- What are materials?
- What are the properties of materials?
- How do we use materials?
- How does the size and shape of objects affect how they move?

Students will engage in hands-on investigations through which they will pose questions and make predictions. They will learn to compare and record their observations and findings.

W@M Wellbeing at Macgregor

Our W@M lessons this term will continue to focus on identifying emotions and applying calming/regulation strategies. Students will explore problem solving techniques to apply in different social situations.



Physical Education & Health

Students will be involved in regular P.E. sessions throughout the week that will focus on fundamental motor skills.
