Welcome back to our final term of Preschool! Our Term 4 focus will be on making connections with children, fostering friendships between children and ensuring preschool is a safe, happy and engaging environment. Our view is that children's lives can be characterised by belonging, being and becoming. From before birth children are connected to family, community, culture and place. Their earliest development and learning takes place through these relationships, particularly within families, who are children's first and most influential educators. As children participate in everyday life, they develop interests and construct their own identities and understandings of the world.

Preschool Learning Program

Labelling Items

SunSmart

Macgregor is a SunSmart school. We teach sensible sun protection habits from an early age and encourage sun protection measures, aiming to reduce skin cancer risk.

Ways to protect your child:

- · clothing that covers shoulders
- apply sunscreen each morning (we prompt children to reapply during the day)
- wear a hat (we provide)
- play in the shade.

<u>Literacy</u>

This term we will continue to build vocabulary, support children to experiment with writing and explicitly teach letter names and sounds. Children will be given opportunities to practise speaking and listening during investigations and group times.

Numeracy

Through investigations, games and routines we will provide opportunities for children to count items, learn aspects of a calendar (days and months) and explore mathematical concepts such as patterns, shape and capacity.

Science

We will be focusing on environmental science which will include the opportunity to view animal and plant lifecycles.
