Mathematics

This term, students will be given many hands-on opportunities to understand and explore:

- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Area and Perimeter
- Time
- 2D/3D Shape.

Integrated Unit - Humanities and Social Science HASS

English



Our explicit English program continues to progress well, with students actively engaged in reading, writing, spelling, comprehension, fluency, and grammar activities. The whole school is also participating in focused handwriting lessons to further support students' writing development.



The Arts

This term, students will focus on visual arts and drama, further developing skills that support creative expression. Through drama, they will explore how the body and voice can be used to express ideas and emotions. In visual arts lessons they will continue to investigate and experiment with the elements of art whilst exploring artworks and styles from various artists.



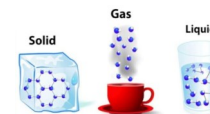
Library

Science

This term, students will continue to build on their understanding of 'States of Matter'.



They will further investigate that everything is made of matter, deepen their exploration of the properties of solids, liquids, and gases, and continue examining how changes in temperature and pressure can cause matter to change from one state to another.

Physical Education & Health

Students will be involved in regular P.E. sessions throughout the week that will focus on the fundamental motor skills. This term, students will learn about **basic hygiene** and the importance of **healthy foods** that help our bodies grow strong and stay well. They will explore simple daily routines, such as washing hands and eating nutritious meals, to support their health and wellbeing.
